#### **EXERCISE FOR PEOPLE OVER 60**


Begin by standing on a comfortable surface, where you have plenty of room at each side.

With a 5-lb potato bag in each hand, extend your arms straight out from your sides and hold them there as long as you can. Try to reach a full minute, and then relax.

Each day you'll find that you can hold this position for just a bit longer.

After a couple of weeks, move up to 10-lb potato bags. Then try 50-lb potato bags and eventually try to get to where you can lift a 100-lb potato bag in each hand and hold your arms straight for more than a full minute. (I'm at this level).

After you feel confident at that level, put a potato in each bag.



### How will the money be used from our BUY A FARM project?

PWRDF raises money to support vulnerable people around the world. Our goal for the project was to raise \$660 from parishioner donations. In fact, we raised \$770. (\$107 came from the empty-out-your-pockets change jar! We can see why every nickel, dime, and quarter adds up.)

Your donations will fund projects in several countries, as follows: **\$140** for a donkey: A donkey will be provided to a family in *Kenya* who need help carrying clean water home from the well. Strong and loyal, a donkey can also provide income by carrying water for other people, and reduce unpaid labour by children and women. Your gift of \$140 will bring the water home.

**\$120** for 3 goats: Community Health Workers are the backbone to healthy families in parts of rural *Malawi*. To supplement their small income, CHWs receive three goats to breed, milk or eventually sell. Your gift will provide three goats and appropriate training to a CHW working with Partners In Health Malawi.

**\$100** for a dairy shed: Dairy Cooperative farmers in *Kenya* are learning to use "smart" techniques to increase their cows 'milk production and family income. Your gift of \$100 will support the construction of climate smart dairy sheds and the appropriate training.



**\$80** for 2 pigs: Women recovering from sexual violence in the *Democratic Republic of the Congo* receive training to be self-reliant and financially independent when they return home. Pigs provides a good source of protein for the family as well as income through sale of manure and meat. Your gift of \$80 provides a pair of piglets to a women recovering from violence.



**\$70** for education in chicken farming: Farmers in *Zimbabwe* are taught to raise chickens and produce fertilizer. Chickens are protein power-houses, producing nutrient rich eggs and meat. Chicken manure is also a secret weapon when it comes to fertilizing gardens, orchards and crops. Your gift of \$70 provides poultry farming training sessions.

**\$50** for 10 rabbits: In *Cuba*, rural families struggle to get enough protein in their diets. Rabbits are easy to care for and provide a culturally appropriate source of protein. They also generate fertilizer that can be sold for profit. Your gift of \$50 provides 10 rabbits to a family working with the Episcopal Church in Cuba.

**\$50** for garden seeds: Participants in *Uganda* learn to sow crops and plant trees to improve their families 'food security and earn an income. Your gift of \$50 will support smallholder farmers become more food secure.

**\$50** for breadfruit trees: The second year of a breadfruit cultivation project in *Haiti* is underway. Women are harvesting breadfruit and milling it into flour to improve local food security and earn an income. Your gift of \$50 will support a woman in Haiti milling 10kg of breadfruit flour.

\$110 that we raised over and above our goal for the Canadian Foodgrains

## **Mom's Crunchy Pineapple Applesauce Bran Muffins**

1 cup buttermilk (or 1 tablespoon vinegar & fill with milk)

1 tsp baking soda 1 cup flour ½ cup butter

½ tsp salt ½ cup brown sugar 1 egg

1 cup bran 1 tbsp molasses ¼ cup applesauce

½ cup drained crushed pineapple handful of raisins & nuts

- combine milk & baking soda & set aside
- cream butter and brown sugar thoroughly, add egg and beat well
- add buttermilk & soda, then molasses and bran and blend
- stir in flour and salt mixture
- fold in fruit & nuts
- spoon into muffin pan, using paper muffin liners (parchment paper liners work best!)
- bake at 375°F for 20 minutes or until done
